
### A Vicar's Thoughts.....

Our worship services are being aired on PEG Access Channel 8. The schedule does change, so be sure to check the website at http://pegaccess.com/channel8programming.html for current times.



Dear Siblings in Christ,

I hope you and your loved ones are healthy and staying safe during this crisis. With physical distance between us, it's easy to feel disconnected. Some of you may have questions about what is happening behind the scenes at First Lutheran Church. As it should be for all of us, my first question addresses mission. Ours is that "as faithful disciples, we serve God and welcome all people with open hearts."



So first, how are we living our mission as a church? The Council has continued to meet on its regular schedule, dealing with ongoing work of the church. Pastor Gretchen has collaborated with our friends at Augustana and Hope Lutheran almost since the beginning of the pandemic-related restrictions, providing meaningful virtual worship experiences for our community. While providing access to worship for those who may not otherwise feel comfortable attending in person, I hope our virtual worship options will continue. Besides that, other church activities such as education and Bible studies, pastoral visits, and more have continued with creative solutions. And we are proactively working towards fully paying our benevolences — a mission-driven budget commitment we made to support community need. And when speaking of mission, we can always strive to do more.



Second, and perhaps the most pressing question for many: When will we open our building? While I must admit to favoring some aspects of virtual worship, such as attending in my pajamas and drinking coffee, I thoroughly miss worship as we know it. That said, there will be changes ahead.



At our June 9<sup>th</sup> council meeting we approved the formation of a Smart Team. This group of 8-10 members will further develop and implement our COVID-19 pandemic operations plan, leading us forward with everyone's spiritual, social, and physical wellbeing in mind. Multiple sources including the ELCA, CDC, and Minnesota Department of Health will guide them. We can trust the Smart Team to make decisions based on available facts and not on emotional pressure. I urge us all to be patient and respect the team's recommendations on access to the building and returning to in-person worship when their work is brought to the Council for action.



Team members were chosen and recruited carefully based on their personal and professional talents, as well as their diverse backgrounds. They will lead us through the details of when and how we adapt as the situation changes. Members include: Calie Anderson, Dr. Joe Dinsmore, Steve Hosch, Dr. Daniel Lembke, Kristi Kvern Wentworth, Missy Mattson, Tara Wagner, and Harriet Wicklund. Pastor Gretchen and I will attend as needed.



Finally: How is First Lutheran doing financially? I believe we can say we are cautiously optimistic. While latest reporting shows close to a \$30,000 income gap compared to budget, our expenses are down as well. In late March, we put a spending freeze in place until we had a more solid picture of the church's position, especially noting potential changes in weekly offering. Our new bookkeeper, Paul (who is doing an awesome job, by the way), reports we have about 90 days cash on hand. Considering the crisis, that's a good position to be in. Thanks so much to each of you who have responded by adapting your financial support of First Lutheran.

I'm also aware some of us have been financially impacted by this crisis. Please continue to give as you are able. As the picture of our situation clears, we'll continue to focus on how we support our church's mission.

Again, I hope and pray this letter finds you well, and that we will see each other in person again soon.
