

## Vicar's Thoughts.....

Apostle Paul writes, "The human body has many parts, but the many parts make up one whole body. So it is with the body of Christ. Some of us are Jews, some are Gentiles, some are slaves, and some are free. But we have all been baptized into one body by one Spirit, and we all share the same Spirit. Cor 12:12-13

Paul writes a lot about the body of Christ. The body of Christ is the church. Our church. Our community. Not a group of independent folks who do as they please. But a group of interconnected, supporting people who hold each other accountable. Our relationship within our community is called Koinonia. Koinonia is a Greek word often translated as fellowship. It means we participate in life together. It means we participate in life with Christ – we share his life and mission.

Seems like a tall order, doesn't it? In a world that has an overabundance of information, distractions and viewpoints, it is easy to not participate in life with others. To say I'm busy this summer is an understatement. So it is easy for me to focus on the to do list – doing the item that is screaming to be done first. But that is not community. It is not Koinonia. I begin to lose my balance in life. When I begin to teeter-totter, I have to ask myself – how can I do Koinonia? Maybe it is answering a friend's question via the telephone rather than text. Or by offering to do a little thing that helps the community.

When I participate in community, life is better. Koinonia is good for the soul. No matter how busy you are this summer, remember to participate in the lives of those in our church and in the life of Christ.




## Lutheran World Relief School Kits
