



First Lutheran Church 1872 - 2022


Mary Bjorgum Harig Johnson, her history runs deep at First Lutheran Church

On October 10, 1872, Den Norske Evangeliske Lutherske Kirke (The Norwegian Evangelic Lutheran Church, now called First Lutheran Church), was organized.

Among the charter members was **Thorsten Bjorgum** and his family. **Thorsten Bjorgum** was born in 1837. He married Mali Liran in 1859. They came to America in 1869 and settled in Otter Tail County in 1871. They had three children, Mary in 1874, Thea in 1877, and **Albert in 1879**.

Albert and wife Inga had five children, Francis in 1908, Kermit in 1910, Harold in 1912, Melvin in 1914, and Robert in 1918.

Harold and Ida Mae had five children, Alyn in 1940, Gary in 1942, Bonnie in 1946, Wanda in 1955, and Dean in 1960.



Alyn and wife Margaret had four children, Mary in 1961, Thomas in 1962, Anita in 1963 and Wendy in 1966.

Mary married Thomas Harig in 1979 and had three sons. Thomas in 1981, Michael in 1982, and Christopher in 1986. She later married Greg Johnson in 1992.

Chris is still a member of FLC. Chris married Amanda Amundson in 2014. They have two daughters Amelia in 2016, and Hazel in 2019. Watch for those cute little girls sitting near the front on the left side in the sanctuary, as they grow into the eighth generation of Bjorgum's at First Lutheran Church.
