I cannot stop thinking about our students as we celebrate the end of a school year, attend graduation celebrations, empty out backpacks and put leftover school supplies away. Art projects, school pictures, clay sculptures, track and field ribbons, a year full of memories come spilling out at this time of year. This was suddenly interrupted at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas last week.

How do we respond in faith? A member of First Lutheran Church asked if we could have a prayer vigil. She shared it with a few others. Plans are now set 7 hours later! People are being invited to take up candles, prayers, and voices to let our children know we DO care about their safety and wellbeing. PLEASE come and bring others as we pray and participate in the healing of deep wounds.

I don't have answers, but I believe in God's infinite power lived out through the Body of Christ. I believe that together, we can and will change the world for the better with Good News, Hope, Unconditional Love first shown to us through our Savior. Summer is a time we can deliberately talk about this and other things that hit home.

How about after worship once a month we have "coffee talk." The topic would be a current event and ways we can respond in faith. Let's try it June 5th at 10:50 a.m. after everyone gets their coffee and donut. Meet in the courtyard/patio area weather permitting/Kairos room as a back up. First topic is How to Respond in Faith to School Shootings? Reflecting and Responding after the School Shooting at Robb Elementary School and the Community of Ulvade, TX.

Meanwhile, we lift up our prayers, candles and voices on behalf of ones so innocent.







If you would like to donate candy for the parade, please drop it off in the Narthex by June 10.Thank YOU!





150 Years of Spiritual Growth

A monthly Messenger feature as we head towards the 150th Celebration of First Lutheran Church

First Lutheran Church 1872 - 2022

1919 Cyclone Destroys Church

(taken from "Blessed...to be a Blessing", the book published for the 125th anniversary of First Lutheran Church)



The devasting cyclone that struck Fergus Falls in 1919 touched the lives of all the residents. Fifty people were killed and over 400 houses, a quarter of the

businesses, and all but two of 24 churches were demolished. The church and parsonage of First English Lutheran Church were victims of the cyclone that destroyed two-thirds of the town; forty-four city blocks.

The bell from the demolished church lay in the middle of the intersection of Junius and Court. Undamaged, the bell was retrieved and later hoisted into the tower of the new church built in 1920. All the parsonage furniture was blown away except Mrs. Ylvisaker's china cabinet.



A special meeting of the church Board of Trustees July 18, 1919, centered on the question of what the future would hold for the congregation left without worship space and a home for its pastor. Buying a house for the parsonage and putting a temporary roof over the church basement were ideas that surfaced during the meeting. Although the house purchase did not occur, the trustees acted quickly on preparing to clear the wreckage by asking for help from able-bodied men and boys. A temporary roof was set across the exposed church basement. The damaged par-



sonage was eventually sold and a new house constructed.

During the winter of 1919-1920 the congregation worshiped in the Cozy Theatre; one of the few surviving downtown structures. They also held joint services with Bethlehem Lutheran, also homeless, at the Park Region College. A schedule

of services, some of which were conducted in English and others in Norwegian, was set during a joint meeting of the leaders of Bethlehem and First English churches on October 6, 1919.

An estimated one thousand people attended the new church dedication and 50th anniversary on November 26, 1922, at First English Lutheran Church. According to the Fergus Falls Daily Journal issue of November 27, 1922, the "magnificent church edifice" was filled to overflowing

with many people unable to gain admittance to the worship service. The forenoon service was "both fitting and deeply impressive," according to the Journal article. Clergy participation far outweighed any other congregational event held to date. Dedication of the new church, a Gothic design, was the focus of the morning service. Although the church building was completed almost a year prior to the dedication service, the event was postponed in favor of holding it on the church's 50th



anniversary. An evening service that same day focused on the church's 50th anniversary.

The Altar Guild is responsible for the changing of the paraments in the chancel, caring for the pastors' albs and stoles, preparing the

elements for communion and placing the flowers on the altar each week. Some of this work is done outside of Sunday mornings, but you are welcome to participate in
