Seniors are accessing food assistance programs at the highest rate of 150% rate outside metro areas. Inflation is making this even more difficult. If you feel draw to helping people access food assistance, please consider donating money towards Service Food cards.

Jesus helps us see a need and then meet a need as we heard from our Relay for Life Team's Bake Sale. Most of us have been impacted by cancer in some way, shape or form. This year's fundraising efforts were in memory of Karen Lundstrom who passed away earlier this year. June 19<sup>th</sup> over \$1,400 was raised and on June 26<sup>th</sup>, over \$2,000 was raised and money is still coming in to support the Fergus Falls Cancer Center. We have raised over \$4000 so far. Research continues to advance and makes a difference in the life expectancy of our loved ones.



#### FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No burials or marker installations are allowed without permission.
- The use of a rigid container is required.
- Only two markers are permitted per lot. One may be above ground, at the west end of the lot.
- Foot markers must be installed in a concrete border and follow the contour of the land.
- Planting of permanent flowers or shrubs is prohibited.
- Any flowers or shrubs that become unsightly will be removed at the discretion of the board.
- All flowers, ornaments or decoration (real or artificial) must be secured at least 12 inches above the ground of placed directly on the marker. Items that do not comply will be discarded by July 15<sup>th</sup>. Solar lights are permitted and should be located as close as possible to the headstone.
- The board will not be responsible for items that are stolen, missing, vandalized or damaged.
- If any questions call church office at 218-739-3348 for name of caretaker.

- Casket lot for member of church \$350.00 nonmember \$450.00.
- Cremations lots for member of church \$250.00 nonmember \$350.00.
- Internment fee will be casket summer \$250.00 winter \$350.00 or \$300.00 if paid at time of purchase.



- Internment fee per cremation will be summer \$150.00 winter \$250.00 or \$200.00 if paid at time of purchase.
   For any lots sold after April 1, 2022
- Transfer fee of cemetery lot is \$50.00
- Summer is from April 01 to October 31.

First Lutheran Church 1872 - 2022

#### Interview with life member Steve Leitte

Steve is a life time member of FLC. The son of Les Leitte, whose father John was born in Norway in 1881 coming to America in 1886, and finally settling in Fergus Falls in 1918.

John Leitte was on the committee to decide the church's future after the cyclone of 1919.

John had three children, confirmed in 1928,1929, and 1933. Les being the oldest son had four children, Steve and three sisters. Steve remembers going to Tuesday School every week. You would go home for lunch, come back to school for a little while then everyone would walk to their church. This was grades 3 through 6. Then when he was in confirmation classes, they were held on Saturdays from 9-11am. There was a lot of memorization and discussions every week. The class was made up of mostly boys and only a few girls. There were 26 kids in the class. On Sunday mornings all of the kids from the neighborhood who went to FLC would pile into one family's car and the dad would bring them to Sunday School. The parents would meet them all later for the service. Even back then, everyone "sat in their own spots"!



Steve married Sue Hanse the end of December 1967 at First Lutheran Church with a temperature outside of -36 degrees! They blew the circuit breakers because of all the extra heaters they had plugged in trying to make the sanctuary warm. When they blew everything went dark. Pastor Preus went down stairs with a flashlight to turn the breakers back on. Sue came to Fergus Falls to take a teaching position and on her second day

in Fergus Falls Pastor if she

Preus came calling on her to see if she would be interested in coming to First Lutheran Church. That is how she became a member of FLC before they were married. Steve and Sue had two girls Lynn, confirmed 1984 and Julie, confirmed in 1986.

Steve has been on the cemetery committee since 1987. He was very active with the Boy Scouts which the church started sponsoring on December 11, 1923 continuing to 1980. Then it was revived in 1983 and continued until 2016. Steve's grandfather John Liette was awarded a scouting metal of honor from President Ford for being a Scout Leader for 50 years. John was one of the charter



members that started the scouts at FLC in 1923. Steve also received honors for 27 winter campouts that he participated in helping with. Steve remembers participating in a pancake feed fundraiser every year to raise money for their scouting activities. The scouts helped clean the church grounds and cemetery's every year in the spring. Les Leitte had a good hunting and fishing relationship with Pastor Chris Preus. It started in 1947 and continued for the next 50 years. Steve also became part of the group. He experienced hunting deer in northern Minnesota and fishing in Canada with them. Pastor Chris Preus continued to enjoy this group of men into his 90's. Steve and Sue continue to be active in First Lutheran Church. Thank you, Steve, for sharing some of your memories of First Lutheran Church.


Music Committee
