MID-WEEK LENTEN SERVICES

The five ELCA churches in Fergus Falls are once again partnering to do joint Mid-Week Lent Worship services with each church hosting one Wednesday of worship services and meals. Each church will have their own Ash Wednesday worship services on February 22 and the rotations will be Wednesdays, March 1-March 29.

An offering will be taken at all the worship services, all designated checks and envelopes will go to their respective churches, so we ask that you please write out your checks or envelopes to First Lutheran Church. Loose offering (cash) will be given to a charitable organization.

This year we will explore the book of Jonah through a series called "Unfinished: Out of the Depths." A bit about the theme: Jonah walks a Lenten path. Like all human beings, he is prone to wander from his Creator in favor determining the shape and scope of his own future. This temptation is especially powerful when God calls us to take on risky ventures, travel to strange places, and confront things inside of us that prevent us from seeing one another as God does. God meets us in those liminal, Lent-like spaces when we find ourselves somewhere between trust and doubt, courage and fear, anger, and empathy.

We invite you to come and worship with us, and to join with our larger faith community in Fergus Falls, as we journey through the season of Lent together.

Unfinished Business: Discovering God's Call in the Not Yet

Dear Friends of First,

God's Call is ever before us as we prepare for the work of transition, nominating people for the call committee, and prepare for Lent 2023.

We get calls all the time. Friends, family, strangers often call, and we choose which ones to answer. Some calls are invitations to renew friendships over a meal. Some are calls to be open to new adventures such as serving on a new committee or ministry. Some are calls to openness for listening to coworkers or neighbors in need.

The Good News of Jesus Christ calls us into unfinished business of the already and not yet. As First Lutheran Church, we will be reflecting, listening and discerning God's Call in these next few months. This includes:

Our Church Council Structure: The church council is the governance of the church. FLC has been informally restructuring from 2020 onward. It is time to formally look at this and process what works best for FLC in the present. The council will be prayerfully and intentionally looking at different church council structures and transitioning to the one that works best for such a time as this. This process will take 3-4 months to find the best fit. It will also entail a congregational meeting to make the necessary changes in the constitution and bylaws.

<u>Forming a Call Committee:</u> Soon, the Church Council will be asking for nominations for a call committee. Our constitution states that the church council appoints the call committee. While this is true, the best practice is to have the entire congregation involved in this process.

<u>Transition Team:</u> This team will assist the call committee in arranging for listening circles and other research that needs to happen for the best overall picture of the congregation and the larger community.

Congregational Forums: As a part of this process, we want to have complete transparency. Please know my door is always open and my cell phone number is available from the office. We will be holding regular congregational forums to inform and update the congregation as well as provide a time for people to ask questions.

God's call is unfolding before us, and we will listen together for where God is leading the way. Together, we will faithfully answer the call and be sent forward by God's many blessings to be a blessing in this community and world.


Two Opportunities for Thrivent Members


