

The Rose Window: Our symbol of Lutheran faith, the window to the west is a representation of Luther's Rose, a long-used, traditional symbol of the Lutheran faith. The five-leafed rose, representing the blood of Christ and divine love, holds a central cross. Constructed of clear, beveled glass, the cross mirrors the Nativity Star in the opposite Great Commission window. Next month, we'll take a look at the creation windows.


An FLC Library Book Review

The church library committee asked that I write a review of the "A.D. Chronicles," a twelve-book series written by Bodie and Brock Thoene. This fictional series is a Biblically based account of the last three years of Jesus' life and the people He healed, taught, dealt with, and walked with. The first book of the series, "First Light," is a story of Peniel's life before and after Jesus healed him of blindness. Several following books are told through Peniel's 'eyes' as he follows Jesus and his disciples. The later books are more about the lives of the people Jesus healed, saved and raised from the dead.

Anthony and I read the first seven together and I just finished the last five. We found the books to be well written, insightful of the times, and inspirational. We wanted to share these books with our church family, so you can now find all twelve in our Church Library. Check them out!




