June 28 at Zion and continue through August 23. Come and join us for Reminders of God's Grace as we share Notes of Hope.


Pay attention to what bring a spark of joy in your life. It very well may be the Holy Spirit compelling you to share the life of faith.

The Worship Corner

On the north side of the gathering space, stained glass occupies only the clerestory windows providing and unobstructed view of the beautiful courtyard. As we begin "In the Beginning" notice how just as God separated light form darkness, the glass moves from darker to brighter as you move from left to right, filled with color and light to mirror God's creation. On the second day, God separated the dome of the sky from the waters. On the third day, God created the dry land; the earth's flourishing vegetation echoes the New Testament reference to the vine, branches and fruits of the Spirit. On the fourth day, God established day and night, populating them with lights of bright sun, gleaming moon in all its phases and glitter-

ing stars. Below, a tree of life undergoes the changes of each season, bearing fruit which ripens and falls in the act of regeneration. Living creatures of all kinds were brought forth on the fifth day and this window teems with life in its wondrous variety. Amid birds filling the sky, the central dove in flights symbolizes the Holy Spirit present in Goad's good creation, hovering over the sea and its denizens. Unifying all these windows is a ribbon of light, beginning in the first window. In the second window, the ribbon becomes the line separating sea and sky and on the third day this ribbon become a vine with bears lush fruit. In day four the ribbon of light is depicted as a rainbow, a sign of God's promise. On the fifth day, it flows in a smooth current, forming the waters that are the lifeblood of the sea creatures. On the sixth day, God created humankind, in his own image, placing the first man and woman in a beautiful garden, filled with the abundance of flowers, birds and animals. From above, the hand of the Creator extends in a gesture of peace, with human hands uplifted to receive the blessing of life. Above the entrance, the window depicts the seventh day, a day of rest and celebration of God's Creating. Its message of welcome is appropriate as described in Hebrews 4: "So then a sabbath rest still remains for the people of God; for those who enter God's rest also cease from their labors as God did from His".
