Happy EAGTER!!

Life-Altering Alleluias! Christ is Risen!

Dear Friends.

This month we move from Lenten reflections to Easter actions and alleluias, ones that have shaped us and captured the meaning of life in full color. We encourage you to invite friends, relatives, neighbors, and coworkers on this life altering journey.

Palm Sunday (March 24):

Palm Sunday leads us into Holy Week with shouts of Hosannas and cheers for our Savior. We wildly wave palm branches that will turn into next year's ashes for Ash Wednesday. The parade chases after the dreams of a strong ruler like King David, yet as we follow we discover the suffering servant king of Jesus of Nazareth.

Jesus' triumphal ride on a donkey or colt stands in stark contrast next to the mighty war horse or gallant steed Caesar might have chosen. Jesus rides plain-clothed, sandals and leather belt, devoid of any armor or sword. His followers don't hold dignified titles and land. Jesus' followers hold onto faith, knowing this Passover will be like none other.

Moving towards Maundy Thursday on March 28th:

First Communion Class happens when students prepare their chalice for Maundy Thursday's first taste of the Lord's Supper. The intent of the shaping of the clay, attention to detailing the grapes or a loaf of bread on the stem, and turning out the top lip of the cup is all so purposeful in these youthful hands. They choose glazes that reflect faith and hope for this moment that gathers all ages and the ancestors together around Jesus' table. We become a part of the Last Supper.

Good Friday on March 29th:

Few people want to face death, much less the death of our Savior. Yet, most people say this is one of their most treasured worship experiences of the year. The depths of Christ's Passion on the Cross remind us how Jesus the Christ takes on sin, death, and the devil. When it seems like evil has won, we wait... for a glimmer of hope.

Happy Easter on March 31st!!!!

The Hope of the Resurrection bursts forth with life altering Alleluias! Against all odds, Jesus Christ is Risen! Whenever it seems like death has won in the world, look out. This is where Jesus works at bringing forth new life. Pay

attention to the signs of new life. Blades of grass, crocus' breaking through, signs of unfolding newness all around us point to resurrection. We witness this in poignant ways as our dusty, brown landscape awakens into life once again.

May this life-altering journey bless you as we continue following the living Christ.




He is risen! Hallelujah! The season of Easter (or the Paschal season) focuses on celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The season traditionally lasts forty days to commemorate the time Jesus remained on earth before His ascension. Ascension is on a Thursday, but most churches observe that day the following Sunday. In our Lutheran church, the Easter season ends with Pentecost, bringing the season to fifty days. The Paschal candle is lit for all services during the Easter season, ending with Pentecost. It will then be lit at each celebration of baptism and at funerals, reminding us that we live and die in Christ and are raised with Him to eternal life.

Meals by Wheels of Fergus Falls

In 1971 the Social Services Department and Lake Region Hospital put out a call for help to local churches to deliver meals to the elderly, shut-ins, and those unable to prepare their own. Ever since that time First Lutheran has made it their mission to reach out to people in need by delivering a hot meal 5 days a week on a rotating bases with other churches and other volunteers.

Knocking on a door and handing a hot lunch to a person who needs it is quite a humbling experience. Some are shy or reserved and some are profoundly grateful. It brings to mind Jesus' words, "I was hungry and you fed me." Amazing! And it only requires about 1 1/2 hours of a volunteer's time.

Here's how it works.

- 1. Sign up at church for a shift.
- 2. Arrive at the Senior Center between 11:00 and 11:30 am on your assigned day to pick up the meals.
- 3. Follow the route you are given and knock on the door. Hand over the food and wish the person a good day.
- 4. Return the food coolers to the Senior Center's back door.
- 5. Return home and thank God for your many blessings.

If you feel you would like to help (even occasionally) please call the church office. Our next turn is the week of April 1-5. We generally go in pairs and it is truly rewarding!







